


# Savor the secrets of Surry

**July 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup>**





A wide assortment of native Virginia food vendors will be available with menus that include world famous pork barbecue, fried pork ribs, grilled pork chops, sausage, ham biscuits, peanut pie, and peanut brittle. Come with your appetite and plan to stay all day! Admission is \$5 per person, children 10 and under are free when accompanied by an adult. The Pork, Peanut and Pine Festival is held in beautiful Chippokes Plantation State Park in Surry County.



## Chippokes Plantation State Park

Chippokes ranks among the oldest working farms in the nation, and retains its original 1619 boundary. Preserved as a 1,683 acre State Park overlooking the James River, it features two 19th century manor houses, formal gardens, and dependencies. The attractions include a swimming complex, visitor center, public facilities, and horseback/hiking/biking.


